

Terms and Conditions

Please make sure that you are aware of your responsibilities of the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 https://www.worksafe.govt.nz/laws-and-regulations/acts/hswa

No smoking is allowed onsite.

Operators, Exhibitors and Drivers of any machine or vehicle shall not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol inside the Wairarapa A&P Showgrounds.

Only suitably qualified people are to operate or drive vehicles or machinery on the Wairarapa A&P Showgrounds. Operators, Exhibitors or Drivers of any machine or vehicle being moved, operated or driven inside the Wairarapa A&P Showgrounds shall be 16 years of age and over and competent to do so.

Powder or foam types of fire extinguishers are required to be present at the display area for every stationary engine exhibitor.

No passengers on vehicles or machinery unless the vehicle or machine is designed for passengers. No standing on any vehicle or machinery drawbars.

Walking speed is the maximum speed for any vehicle or machine moving inside the Wairarapa A&P Showgrounds.

Fuel shall be kept in safety containers. Petrol in a maximum of 10 litre container and Diesel in a maximum of 20 litre. No fuel will be supplied onsite.

All Wheels at Wairarapa event Facilitators and/or Convenors are Health and Safety Officers. Their decisions are final in any issue or dispute.

A continuous ring programme will feature daily,, with displays of tractors, trucks, cars, bikes, stationary engines, threshing, chaff cutting, baling, fertiliser spreading and anything on wheels and tracks.

Loading banks are available at the Wairarapa A&P Showgrounds.

Please note the setup times below. Onsite security will be provided to ensure that everything is safe.

Tickets:

• EXHIBITORS

There is no registration fee to exhibit your wheels.

You will receive FREE entry for the 3 days of the show as part of your registration. 1 entry per vehicle registration.

We do require you to purchase an EXHIBITOR SUPPORTER TICKET for any support crew. The link is available on the registration form.

The ticket price is \$15 per person which will allow access for all 3 days. You an any supporters will receive wristbands upon entry.

• TRUCK SHOW COMPETITORS

For those entering their Trucks in the one day Truck show the registration fee of \$20 per truck will entitle them to one free gate entry, a pass will be emailed to you, and must be displayed in the windscreen of your vehicle to gain entry to the grounds

Additional tickets can be purchased at \$15 per person over 15 years old via the ticket link on our website.

TRADE SITES & STALL HOLDERS

You will be contacted directly by the Wairarapa A&P Society in regards to your specific Ts & Cs and invoicing details.

Camping: (EXHIBITORS)

Registered exhibitors will receive FREE camping on site if they wish to redeem it online. Free camping ONLY applies to the ONE registered party. All support crew must purchase discounted camping tickets for \$20 each for 3 nights.

These Non-Powered, Self Contained sites are available from Thursday 2nd February – midday to Wednesday 8th February.

Exhibitor camping is separate from public camping. Your site will be located in a specially designated area on the Eastern side of the Showgrounds.

Please note - These sites are non-powered.

There are no kitchen or shower facilities at this site so a self-contained motorhome is preferred. There is a toilet block nearby.

Camping: (GA)

A special event camping rate of \$20 for 3 nights is available for purchase online.

These are STRICTLY for self-contained vehicles and for non-powered sites.

You must be able to show an up to date Self-Containment certificate on arrival.

Please note there are a limited number of sites and therefore prior bookings are essential.

Camping will be strictly inside the area delegated for camping.

There will be no unauthorised camping within the event site, if you are found to be camping onsite and do not have approval, you will be asked to leave.

 Set up by 9.00am on the day (You may want to set up early for the Truckies on the Sunday)




Map:
